

Admin Name Order Comment **for Magento 2**

User & Installation Guide

Overview

The Admin Name Order Comment extension for Magento 2 is a simple but really useful extension which gives you the ability to display next to the order comments in Magento admin, the username of the commentator. Solving the problem when you have more than one person serving Magento orders and you want to know who added every comment. Commentator's username is only shown in the Magento admin (order view and comments history tab) and is not visible to the customer.

Key Features

- Display commentator's username next to the order comments in Magento admin (order view and comments history tab)
- Commentator's username is visible only in Magento admin and not to the customer

Other Features

- Developed by a Magento Certified Developer
- Meets Magento standard development practices
- Single License is valid for 1 live Magento installation and unlimited test Magento installations
- Simple installation
- 100% open source

Compatibility

Magento Community Edition 2.4

Download the Extension

- 1 Sign in to your account at www.magevision.com
- 2 Navigate to My Account » My Downloads
- 3 Find the extension and click to download it
- 4 Extract the downloaded ZIP file in a temporary directory
- 5 Backup your web directory and store database

Before installing the extension, backup your web directory and store database. All our extensions are tested on clean Magento installations. We can not guarantee compatibility with third party extensions or customized Magento installations. We recommend to install any extension you obtain from us on a testing Magento installation first and then on a live Magento installation in case of incompatibility with third party extensions.

Installing the Extension

Using an Archive and FTP

Upload the extracted folders and files of the extension to the base (root) Magento directory. Do not replace the whole folders, but merge them. If you have downloaded the extension from Magento Marketplace, then create the following folder path `app/code/MageVision/AdminNameOrderComment` and upload there the extracted folders and files.

Connect via SSH to your Magento server as, or switch to, the Magento file system owner and run the following commands from the root Magento directory:

```
cd path_to_the_magento_root_directory
php bin/magento maintenance:enable
php bin/magento module:enable MageVision_AdminNameOrderComment --clear-static-content
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
php bin/magento maintenance:disable
```

Log out from Magento admin and log in again.

Via Composer (Magento Marketplace)

Connect via SSH to your Magento server as, or switch to, the Magento file system owner and run the following commands from the root Magento directory:

```
cd path_to_the_magento_root_directory
php bin/magento maintenance:enable
composer require magevision/module-admin-name-order-comment
php bin/magento module:enable MageVision_AdminNameOrderComment --clear-static-content
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
php bin/magento maintenance:disable
```

How to Use

Once installed, the extension works automatically. Navigate to any order in Magento Admin under Sales § Orders and open it. The commentator's username will be displayed next to each order comment in both the order view and the comments history tab.
